- \* **Garbage**- clear non colored bags- **Recyclables**- clear non colored or transparent blue.
- \* Residential collection limit- 4 bags of garbage/collection, no recycling limit.
- \* Business collection limit- 8 bags of garbage & recyclables/collection.
- \* All materials must be placed for collection by **6:30 a.m.**

#### Collection Routes

**MONDAY:** Amherst Point, Brookdale, East Amherst, Fort Lawrence, Hastings, Nappan & Upper Nappan (North of Nappan River), Salem, Stanley, West Amherst.

**TUESDAY:** Black River Road, Chignecto, Claremont, Fenwick, Glenville, Little Forks (North of Railway), Maccan (East of river), Nappan & Upper Nappan (South of Nappan River), Oxford Junction, River Philip, Salt Springs, Thomson Station, Valley Road.

**WEDNESDAY:** Amherst Head, Amherst Shore, Chapman Settlement, Lorneville, Lower Shinimicas, Northport (West of and including Shinimicas Rd), Shinimicas (except Mt Pleasant Rd & Hwy 6 East of Shinimicas Rd), Tidnish Bridge, Tidnish Cross Roads, Truemanville, Tyndal Road, Warren.

**THURSDAY:** Beckwith, Conns Mills, East Leicester, Kolbec, Lake Killarney, Linden, Little River, Mansfield, Mount Pleasant, West Leicester, Port Howe, Northport (East of Shinimicas Rd), Port Philip, Pugwash River, Riverview, Shinimicas (Mt Pleasant Rd & Hwy 6 East of Shinimicas Rd), West Pugwash.

**FRIDAY:** Birchwood, Gulf Shore, Hansford, Hartford, Middleboro, Miller Rd, Pugwash, Pugwash Junction, South Pugwash, Rockley, Roslin, Victoria, Wallace Bay.

# TRANSFER STATION GUIDE & SCHEDULE

## REMINDERS

- ◆ Persons entering the site do so at their own risk.
- ◆ Scavenging is prohibited.
- ◆ All loads must be secure. Unsecure loads will be rejected.
- ◆ Garbage must be in clear bags.
- ◆ Recyclables-clear non coloured or transparent blue bags.
- ◆ Cardboard must be flattened.
- ◆ Customers may be asked to provide ID.
- ◆ Businesses in areas served by curbside collection may not use the sites.
- ◆ Commercial waste must be hauled separately from residential.
- ◆ All metal drums must be empty with one end removed.
- ◆ Oil tanks must be cut in half.
- ◆ No loads larger than a pickup truck as determined by the attendant.
- ◆ Unacceptable materials include propane tanks, tires, and household hazardous waste. For more information call 667-5141.

Leaves, plants, garden waste  
Root balls  
Sawdust/wood chips  
Trees, limbs- less than 6" diameter
