First Reading of the Amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to rezone 467 MacDonald Road, Upper Nappan was completed at the April 15th, 2020 Council session.  - 2.4 ii) Livestock Control Bylaw

First Reading of the Livestock Control Bylaw was completed at the April 15th, 2020 Council session. The purpose of the Livestock Control By-Law is to set out guidelines for livestock owners which will protect the wellbeing of neighbouring properties and the public. As this is a Public Hearing, Council will hear comments, concerns and questions from residents. Should Council agree, following the Public Hearing, Council may make a motion to advertise for Second Reading of this amendment to the Land Use Bylaw at the June 3rd Council session.

 - 2.4 iii) Public Sewer Bylaw

First Reading of the Public Sewer Bylaw was held at the April 15th, 2020 Council session. The purpose of the proposed Public Sewer By-Law is to outline the operational aspects of the sewer systems (i.e. the connection and disconnection process), define the manner in which sewer charges are calculated and assigned, and set out the specifications for what is acceptable to discharge to a public sewer. As this is a Public Hearing, Council will hear comments, concerns and questions from residents. Should Council agree, following the Public Hearing,

Council may make a motion to advertise for Second Reading of this amendment to the Land Use Bylaw at the June 3rd Council session.

Action: Hold Public Hearing

2.4 iv) Local Improvement Bylaw

First Reading of the Local Improvement Bylaw was held at the April 15th, 2020 Council session. The purpose of the proposed Local Improvement By-Law is to establish the way that the Municipality will charge and enforce payment of charges for local improvements such as water systems and sewer systems. The properties to be rated or charged will be determined on a project by project basis and be included in, or added to, Schedule "A" of the By-law. As this is a Public Hearing, Council will hear comments, concerns and questions from residents. Should Council agree, following the Public Hearing, Council may make a motion to advertise for Second Reading of this amendment to the Land Use Bylaw at the June 3rd Council session.
