Waste Management Special Collection Schedule

Regular collection day	Special collection day	Reminders
Tuesday, Week 2	→ April 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All materials must be placed for collection by 7:00 a.m. on Monday of your scheduled week. • C&D, metals, & bulky items must be in 3 separate piles. C&D must be in a pile, no larger than 4ft x 4ft x 8ft. • Leaf & yard waste will not be collected during special collection. • Do not place items out more than 3 days before your scheduled collection.
Wednesday, Week 1 & 2	→ April 21	
Thurs. & Friday, Week 1	→ April 28	
Thurs. & Friday, Week 2	→ May 20	
Monday, Week 1 & 2	→ May 26	

Pile 1. Metals

Refrigerator, freezer, washer & dryer, stove, barbeque, etc.

Pile 2. Bulky Garbage Items

Furniture, mattress, box spring, chair, table, desk, **pressure treated lumber (bundled)**, etc.

Pile 3. Construction & Demolition Debris

Doors, windows, siding, toilet, drywall, shingles.
No pressure treated lumber.
Shingles & insulation must be bagged.

Construction of Springhill's new fire station nearing completion.

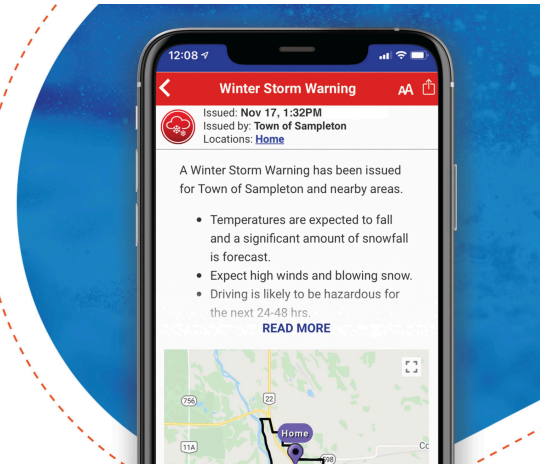
