DAY CAMPS

KIDSPORT NS GRANT PROVINCIAL FUND

Applicants are encouraged to read the eligibility information noted here and ensure they meet the criteria before beginning an application. If eligible, please review and complete an application and all requested supplementary information by the 15th of each month.

Together with a network of 13 local chapters, KidSport Nova Scotia provides grants to help cover the costs of sport registration and equipment fees so that all kids aged 18 and under in Nova Scotia can play a season of sport.

Managed and operated in Nova Scotia by Sport Nova Scotia since 1994, KidSport Nova Scotia has assisted over 37,400 children by granting out over \$10.1 Million!

Girls At Bat is an introductory level baseball program designed to reduce some of the biggest barriers anyone identifying* as a girl may face when accessing or participating in sport. Some of these barriers include, but are not limited to, sport being too competitive, having a perceived lack of skill, limited access to opportunity, and low confidence. Girls At Bat works to remove these barriers by creating spaces that empower and centre the leadership and voices of girls and provide opportunities for them to learn and play sport amongst a resilient and inclusive community. 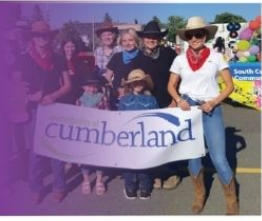

Thank you for your interest in an exciting experience with our summer programming staff this summer. We are confident you and your child(ren) will enjoy yourselves tremendously as you participate in a variety of creative, fun, active and exciting games, songs, sports, art, outdoor challenges, visits from special guests, water play and so much more!

The Municipality of Cumberland Department of Recreation & Community Services is committed to providing a positive, engaging recreation experience for all participants. To achieve this goal, we expect participants to show respect and consideration for staff and fellow participants, be cooperative and engage in activities, respect programming rules, the facility and program equipment.

Our summer staff are carefully selected based on their past experiences, skills, enthusiasm, and ability to work with children and participants of all ages. All our staff must attend mandatory training on topics such as leadership, motivation, teamwork, parents feedback, policies, and procedures, as well as specifics about programming and management expectations. All summer staff are certified in First Aid/CPR, HIGH FIVE principles of Healthy Child Development, NCCP fundamental movements, Food Handlers, Duty to Report, and Autism NS training.

We want you to know that your child is in a caring and safe environment. We ensure the safe supervision of all participants by monitoring and maintaining staff-to-participant ratios for the appropriate age group and by completing head counts throughout the day, from one transition to the next. We hope you enjoy a wonderful summer with us!
