### About the Role

### Responsibilities and Duties

- a. Greet customers and take drink orders.
- b. Check identification and ensure customers meet age requirements for alcohol consumption.
- c. Mix and serve drinks according to customer preferences and established recipes.
- d. Assist with inventory management and ordering supplies when necessary.
- e. Maintain a clean and organized bar area.
- f. Operate cash registers and handle financial transactions with customers.
- g. Adhere to all applicable health and safety standards, including the *Smoke-free Places Act* and the *Health Protection Act* and *Food Safety Regulations*.
- h. Engage with customers to provide a positive and enjoyable atmosphere.
- i. Communicate with other staff members to ensure efficient and smooth operations during events.
- j. Perform other duties as assigned or required.
