About the Role

The Seasonal Campground Attendant is responsible for performing a variety of physical labour tasks related to repairing, cleaning and maintaining the Municipality's Glooscap Campground's infrastructure, facilities and grounds. This position involves working outside in a range of weather conditions and requires physical fitness.

The Campground Attendant reports to the Glooscap Campground Manager. This position is located at the Glooscap Campground near Parrsboro.

Responsibilities and Duties

- a. Perform various tasks such as painting, basic installations, moving equipment and materials, and preparing campsites for check ins.
- b. Perform minor construction duties, maintenance tasks and repairs on Campground assets and facilities.
- c. Perform maintenance tasks such as mowing, planting, weeding, raking, and whipper snipping.
- d. Maintain grounds cleanliness, including litter pick up and washing picnic tables.
- e. Maintain facilities cleanliness, including cleaning showers, washrooms, outhouses, and Recreation Hall.
- f. Operate small power tools and outdoor power equipment, such as drills, saws, and pressure washers to complete tasks.
- g. Ensure work is performed in compliance with applicable health and safety standards, including requirements from the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations.
- h. Perform duties in a cost-effective manner.
- i. Perform other duties as assigned or required.

Qualifications

- a. A valid Nova Scotia driver's license.
- b. Physical ability to perform work involving lifting, carrying, pushing, and pulling.
- c. Strong problem solving, interpersonal, and communication skills.
- d. Ability to prioritize tasks and remain focused.
- e. Ability to work independently and in a team environment.
- f. Experience as a Campground Attendant is preferred.
- g. Grade 12 or demonstrated equivalent experience
- h. Agree to provide a Criminal Records Check, Vulnerable Sector & Child Abuse Registry.

- i. A valid First Aid Certificate and WHMIS is a requirement for this position, or willing to obtain certification
- j. Must be available to work irregular work hours including evenings and holidays.
- k. Knowledge of the area considered an asset.
