

Municipality of Cumberland By-Law 21-08

By-Law to Amend the Solid Waste By-Law (By-Law 18-02)

1. This By-Law is entitled the By-Law to Amend the Solid Waste By-Law 21-08.
2. Sections 29 and 30 of By-Law 18-02, as repealed by By-Law 21-04, are hereby replaced as follows:

29. No person shall export or remove solid waste material generated within the Municipality outside the boundaries of Cumberland County and all such solid waste shall be disposed of within the boundaries of Cumberland County in accordance with this By-Law, except when and as authorized by a Resolution of Council.

30. For the purpose of Section 29, solid waste means solid waste materials, including but not limited to, residual waste, industrial, commercial and institutional waste, construction and demolition waste, mixed waste, and organic materials, but does not include recyclable materials from industrial, commercial and institutional sector premises, pathogenic or biomedical waste, or hazardous waste, materials.

3. This By-Law comes into force upon publication.
